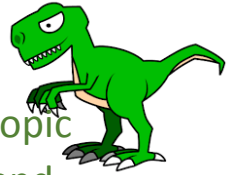


Class 2's Summer Newsletter

History: The story of the first aeroplane flight

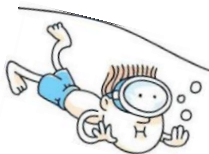
Geography: Compass and direction work, plus basic map knowledge and use
